MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Requirements To Request Restricted Driving Privileges For A (DWI Offense)

1. For a suspension based on Driving While Impaired a memorandum addressed to the Garrison Commander endorsed through your chain of command through the 0-6 level is required. All requests must be signed by person requesting privileges. Endorsement by chain of command must be by signature and not initialed.

2. Proof of verification of attendance in a drug/alcohol, or traffic safety class.

Class is held every Saturday morning at 0800 a.m. in the Safety Training Classroom located in the basement of Soldier Support Center (Old Womack Hospital). Seating is limited and training is conducted on a first come first serve basis. For further questions, please call the Driver Improvement Training Office at 907-0139.

The following individuals are required to attend training based on being charged with 1 of 15 specific offenses.

- a. Service member assigned or attached to Fort Bragg (regardless of whether you live on or off post).
- b. Government employee assigned or attached to Fort Bragg (regardless of whether you live on or off post).
- c. Family member living on post.

Note: Civilians (Retired Military, Civilian Contractors, etc.) are not required to attend.

3. A valid copy of your state driver's license or a copy of N.C. restricted driving permit.
4. A copy of Proof of Insurance.
5. A Certified Copy of court results, if you have been to court, (can be obtained at the Central Record Office at the Law Enforcement Center), or copy of DA 4833 (Commander's Action Report).
