

## MANAGED LAKES

These lakes contain bass, bluegill, redear sunfish, crappie, warmouth, pickerel, and bullhead.

### Big Muddy Lake (66 acres)

This lake is located off Honeycutt Road, 2 miles east of Hwy directions. Boat ramp is good.

### Texas Lake (29 acres)

This lake is located off Honeycutt Road, 2 miles east of Hwy 210. The lake is easily fished from the dam. Boat ramp access is fair.

### McArthur Lake (70 acres)

This lake is located off Manchester Road, 1 mile west of Inverness Road. Shoreline and boat ramp access are good. **Daily limit of largemouth bass is 5. All largemouth bass less than 16 inches long must be released immediately.**

### Mott Lake (138 acres)

This lake is the largest lake on Fort Bragg, and is located off Plank Road, 1 mile east of Raeford-Vass Road. It is easily fished from the shore, and has two excellent boat ramps.

### Little Muddy Lake (31 acres)

This lake is located on Camp Mackall; see map for directions.

### Overhills Lake (36 acres)

This lake is located in NTA 5. A small boat ramp is available. **See map for access points.**

### Croatian Lake (3 acres)

This lake is located in NTA 5. Shoreline access is good. **See map for access points.**

### Deer Pen Lake (4 acres)

This lake is located in NTA 8. Shoreline access is good. Trallered boats are prohibited. **See map for access points.**

### Quail Lake (5 acres)

This lake is located in NTA 8. Shoreline access is good. Trallered boats are prohibited. **See map for access points.**

### Lindsay Lake (51 acres)

This lake is located off Turkey Ridge Road in NTA 3. Boat Ramp is excellent, and there is a fishing pier. **Daily limit**

of largemouth bass is 5; all largemouth bass less than 16 inches long must be released immediately.



## CATFISH LAKES

(Closed daily 0600-1100)

These lakes are stocked annually with channel catfish. Other species like bass, bluegill, crappie and warmouth are present.

**NO BOATS, CANOES, OR FLOTATION DEVICES ARE ALLOWED IN CATFISH LAKES. ONLY BANK FISHING IS AUTHORIZED.**

### Lower McKellars Lake (16 acres)

This lake is located off McKellars Road, behind McKellars Rod & Gun Club. **Daily limit for channel catfish is 3. Minimum size limit is 14 inches.**

### Wyatt Lake (8 acres)

This lake is located off Lamont Road, ½ mile south of the Lamont and Manchester Road intersection. **Daily limit for channel catfish is 3. Minimum size limit is 14 inches.**

### Andrews Church Lake (6 acres)

This lake is located off Andrews Church Road, ½ mile south of the Hwy 210/87 intersection. Lake is approximately 1 mile east of Hwy 87. **Daily limit of channel catfish is 5. No size limit.**

### Moss Gill Lake (7 acres)

This lake is located on Camp Mackall; see map for directions. **Daily limit for channel catfish is 3. Minimum size limit is 14 inches.**

## INTENSIVELY MANAGED LAKES

These lakes are managed for bass, bluegill, redear sunfish, and channel catfish. Some lakes also contain crappie, warmouth and pumpkinseed.

**MINNOWS CANNOT BE USED FOR BAIT IN ANY INTENSIVELY MANAGED LAKES.**

### Simmons Lake (13 acres)

This lake is located off Honeycutt Road east of the Honeycutt and Hwy 210 intersection. Shoreline and boating access are good. **Daily limit for largemouth bass is 5; all largemouth bass less than 16 inches long must be released immediately.**

### Holland Lake (11 acres)

This lake is located off Manchester Road, ½ mile west of the Longstreet and Manchester Road intersection. Shoreline and boating access is fair.

### McFayden Pond (8 acres)

This pond is located on Butner Road at Wilson Park. It is open to youth only (under 16) accompanied by an adult sponsor with appropriate fishing permits. Adults may not fish. Shoreline fishing only; access is good. **Open during daylight hours only.**

### Hurley Lake (8 acres)

This lake is located off Marks Road in NTA 3. Shoreline and boating access are fair. **Daily limit for largemouth bass is 5; all largemouth bass less than 16 inches long must be released immediately.**

**All lakes are off limits to swimming, water skiing, and jet skis.**

**No boat motor size restriction on Big Muddy, McArthur and Mott Lakes. All other lakes have a maximum 25 horsepower restriction.**

**Fishing along the Little River . . .**  
Fishing is allowed on the Little River, along

the northern boundary of Fort Bragg. The Little River contains bass, redbreast sunfish, bluegill, and catfish. Caution should be used when fishing due to heavy currents, dams, sandbars and deep water. Fishing within 100 meters of any dam, water plant, or sewage treatment plant on the Little River is prohibited.

#### **Temporarily Closed Lakes**

Hutaff Lake - Closed pending construction of new dam and restocking. Reopening TBD.

Keist Lake - Closed due to restocking. Reopen June 2005.

Boundary Line Lake - Closed due to dam modifications and restocking. Reopen June 2006.
