

# Green Clean

## Silver Polish

To polish silver, cover the bottom of an aluminum or enameled pan with aluminum foil. Place your tarnished silver in the pan. Fill with enough water to cover the silver. Add 1 teaspoon of baking soda and 1 teaspoon of salt. Boil for 3 minutes. Remove the silver, wash in soapy water and polish.  
**DO NOT USE THIS METHOD FOR SILVER JEWELRY OR FLATWARE WITH HOLLOW HANDLES.**



## Wood Polish

To polish furniture, combine 2 teaspoons of lemon essential oil with 1 pint of olive oil in a spray bottle. Spray onto a clean, soft cloth and wipe furniture.

This mixture is safe for both varnished and unvarnished furniture.



## Glass Cleaner

To clean glass, mix 2 tablespoons of white vinegar with 1 quart of water. To add a fresh fragrance, add 3 drops of your favorite essential oil such as lemon or lavender. Pour the mixture into a spray bottle.

Spray the mixture onto glass and wipe with newspaper.



## Linen Spray

To create linen spray, place 2 tablespoons of vodka in a spray bottle. Fill the bottle with distilled water, leaving 1.5 inches at the top of the bottle. Add 1 teaspoon of essential oils such as ylang ylang and patchouli for a spicy scent, lavender and vanilla for a calming scent or lemongrass and orange for a fresh scent. Spray the mixture onto your linens.



## All Purpose Cleaner

For an all-purpose cleaner, combine 2 cups of distilled water, 0.5 cup of distilled white vinegar, 1 teaspoon of pure castile (vegetable-based) soap, 20 drops of tea tree essential oil and 20 drops of lavender or lemongrass essential oil into a spray bottle and mix well. This mix is effective at cleaning multiple surfaces including acrylic, ceramic tile, wood, marble and granite.
