Fireworks Safety Information



Fireworks are great fun. Here is some information to help your celebration remain a safe one!

- Always read and FOLLOW directions on the label.
- Always have an adult present to supervise the fireworks activity.
- Always buy from a reliable fireworks dealer.
- Alcohol and fireworks do NOT mix.
- Always use fireworks outdoors, away from homes, dry grass and trees.
- Always keep a water hose close by in case something catches fire.
- Always store your fireworks safely (preferably in a closed box) away from any source of accidental ignition.
- Always store your fireworks in a cool dry place.
- Only light one item at a time.
- Never try to re-ignite malfunctioning fireworks.
- Never give ANY firework item to small children.
- Never throw or point fireworks at another person.
- Never carry fireworks in your pocket.
- Never shoot/fire fireworks from metal or glass containers.
- Never experiment, modify or attempt to make your own fireworks.
- One more thing to remember:
- PETS are frightened by loud noises and bright flashes. Keep your pets indoors while enjoying your fireworks.
