

Fort Bragg Area Community Foundation Grant Application Checklist

1. Am I eligible to request assistance from FBACF?

- Active duty military personnel assigned to Fort Bragg and their spouses
- DOD civilian assigned for Fort Bragg
- Military retiree and spouses residing within 50-mile radius of Fort Bragg
- Fort Bragg units
- Agencies providing direct support to a significant number of Fort Bragg families
- None of the above. You may still be eligible to receive a grant, but must prove a direct relationship to Fort Bragg prior to consideration

2. Obtain and complete FBACF Form #1.

3. Eligible for funds from AER? *Note: ALL FBACF grant requests MUST go through AER.*

Yes

- AER funds completely cover my financial emergency.
STOP. At this time, you are not eligible for a grant from FBACF. Do not submit FBACF Financial Assistance Form.
- AER funds do not completely cover my financial emergency.
SUBMIT FBACF Financial Assistance Form through AER to be considered for a grant.

No

- I am not eligible for AER funds.
SUBMIT FBACF Financial Assistance Form through AER to be considered for a grant.

4. AER will assist you in submitting the FBACF Financial Assistance Form and all supporting documentation (copies of bills, receipts, letters from unit commanders, etc.) to the FBACF 2nd Vice-President. *Note: Failure to provide adequate supporting documentation will result in a denial of your grant application.*

5. FBACF will consider your grant request and you will be notified of the foundation's decision.
