# Fort Bragg 5-Day Forecast

(Valid 0500L 27 October 2016)

**Thursday:** Expect partly cloudy conditions throughout today. Winds will be light and southerly during the morning, increasing to speeds in the upper teens to low 20mph range as the day progresses. Expect a low around 50f and a high in the low-70s.


**Friday:** The day will kick off with light patchy fog giving way to mostly clear skies during the afternoon. Winds will be predominately light, with isolated gusts into the mid-teens throughout the day. Expect a low in the upper 50s and a high in the mid-70s.

**Saturday:** Expect clear skies with winds under 10mph throughout the day. The low temperature will be in the mid-50s, and the high around 80f

**Sunday:** Expect mostly clear skies that will become mostly cloudy during the afternoon. Winds will under 10mph throughout the day. The low temperature will be in the upper-50s, and the high around 80f.

**Monday:** Expect mostly clear skies through today with winds under 10mph from the west-southwest during the day, becoming northerly during the late afternoon. The low temperature will be in the upper-50s, and the high around 75f.


